


AIR ROCKET SAFETY CODE

- Never stand over rocket when launching.
- Keep away from your face when launching.
- Never point or launch rocket at people or animals.
- Use outdoors only in large open spaces.
- Do not fly near roads, power lines or trees.
- Keep spectators at least 15 feet (4.6 m) from launcher.
- Never launch any item except your Air Power Blast Jets™ rocket.


ASSEMBLY TIP: Read all instructions before beginning assembly. Assemble outdoors on level ground. Locate the parts shown below and lay them out in front of you. Check to make sure all parts are included, if any parts are missing, contact the Estes Customer Service Dept. at 800-525-7561, Mon. - Fri. 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Mountain Time.



LAUNCH SYSTEM SETUP



Attach air tube with blue connector to the launcher and twist connector hand tight.




2. Insert launcher with attached air tube into base.


Twist & "Click"

3₌ Snap into place.






4. Attach remaining air tubes as shown, and twist connectors hand tight.




5 ■ Attach air tube assembly to pump and twist connector hand tight.

LAUNCH SYSTEM OPERATION

Important: Move all spectators back 15 feet (4.6 m) from launcher.



Level base and slide rocket onto launcher.

NOTE: Launcher must be LEVEL or rocket will not launch.



Pump 15-25 times, or until you hear air release from the safety valve.



Position glider over spring and attach glider to rocket.

Then push glider up into groove to lock in place as shown. Repeat for other glider.



Clear launch area of spectators. Countdown 5... 4... 3... 2... 1... press the launch button!



Watch the action!

PRE-LAUNCH CHECK

For safety, never launch a damaged rocket. Check the rocket's body, nose cone and fins. If damaged, discontinue use of rocket and call the Estes Customer Service Department for a replacement. [800-525-7561 - Mon. - Fri. 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Mountain Time]

FLYING YOUR ROCKET

Choose a large field (250 ft. [76 m] square). The larger the launch area, the better the chance of recovering your rocket and gliders. Football fields and playgrounds are great. Launch only with little or no wind and good visibility. Do not launch near roads, buildings, power lines or trees. So that you don't lose sight of your jets or rocket, it's a good idea to have another person observe the launch and recovery, as the jets and rocket descend separately.

Always read and follow the Air Rocket Safety Code.
